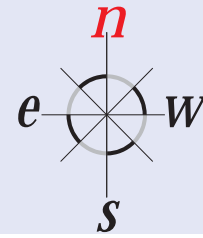


# WATCH & PRAY

## Watch and Pray Ministry Project in Ethiopia

Today, we watch the desolation the fundamental Muslim expansionists are bringing about in Ethiopia and the world in the realm of the spirit. The acts of terrorism, the killing of

innocents, the general hostility to the West can be traced to this spirit of these Muslims. We believe that no sanction, war or diplomatic movement can stop this desolation except the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. God loves the Muslims. He wants to save Muslims from eternal doom, and we are here to do His will. Therefore, let us as children of God unite our hands to commission the work of evangelizing the Muslims of Ethiopia and throughout the world.

To answer this call, we have started a project to build a worship center, kindergarten and clean water site. This project is located 197 km from Addis Ababa in a Muslim community known as Bulbula. Work on the building foundation has begun with the use of funds sent by Watch and Pray. By God's grace, there has been no government interference. Even though our achievements in the project are astonishing, the requirements for this community project are beyond our ministry's financial limit. It is also difficult to cover monthly expenses for the evangelists, but we believe that God will provide. In addition we need to start a small micro business for the evangelists

so that they can be self-supporting. Watch and Pray Ministries is now ascertaining the ability of our donors to provide financial support for the project. The building of the kindergarten and provision of clean drinking water will provide leverage with the local government in meeting the felt needs of the community. Once positive communication is achieved with the authorities, we will plant 25 churches with five evangelists. We also need to train more native workers for the field. Below is the projected cost of this project.

### Project Cost

- A. Expense to bring clean water to the project site 2700.00 USD
- B. Worship center construction 32,700.00USD
- C. Fence construction to provide security 2,500.00 USD
- D. Kindergarten construction 15,000.00 USD
- Sub Total 52,900.00 USD
- 10 % Inflation Contingency 5,290.00
- Total Amount IN USD 58,190.00

Of this amount, \$3,000 has been sent for the foundation work

### Other news from the persecuted church in the Horn of Africa

#### Somalia

On June 15, 2010 the Somali Muslim parents of 17-year-old Fatuma Mohamed, who converted to Christianity, severely beat her for leaving Islam. They have regularly shackled her to a tree at their home for more than a month, Christian sources said. For more information visit

Al Shabaab militants killed another leader of the underground church movement in Somalia, sources said. Yusuf Ali (57) was fatally shot on May 4, 2010 in Xarardheere, about 60 kilometers (37 miles) from Jowhar

#### Eritrea

Currently there are 3,000 believers in different prison locations in Eritrea. Between 2009 and June, 2010, seven believers died in a prison cell due to lack of medical treatment and physical torture.

#### Ethiopia

Evangelical Christians in an area of Ethiopia unaccustomed to anti-Christian hostility have come under attack from Ethiopian Orthodox Church (EOC) members threatened by their existence, Christian leaders said. On January 27, 2010, in Olenkomi, about 65 kilometers (40 miles) west of the Ethiopian capital of Addis Ababa, two church buildings were attacked by an EOC mob in town, Oromia Region Olenkomi. The attack left one evangelist unconscious and other Christians fearful of Orthodox hostility. Area Christians fear the assailants will not face justice due to the EOC's powerful presence and impending elections. In general, we are asking for prayer for the persecuted believers to endure. Please remember those in prison as if you were their fellow prisoners, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering. For more information visit
